Community Garden and Allotment

Turning the amenity land behind the school into allotments to promote sustainable living and make use of the land. Include a community garden with a small orchard.

All Weather Sports Pitch & Changing Facilities

Install an all-weather sports pitch at the Recreation Ground.
Install changing facilities with showers. Install Public Toilets/Baby Change (families at park). Upgrade MUGA (Multi-Use Games Area)

Errol Playpark

- General concepts:
- Facilities outside of school for older years as well as younger ones (more challenging equipment for 8-12 year olds); Zone by ability
- Ideas for new equipment:
- Climbing frames & rope bridges; Ninja + fitness along north edge of playpark; Exercise Equipment - like Dunfermline area for older children. Trim Trail outside the school; Digger equipment (e.g. Camperdown Park); Dirt tracks (e.g. South Inch in Perth)
- General upgrades
- Fence around the playpark: separate small children and dogs/dog mess
 - Improve lighting along the pathways in the park
